Who We Are

Holy Ground Shelter for Homeless, Inc. is an independent faith-based non-profit organization that adheres to Judeo-Christian values. Created out of a profound respect for the God-given gift of life, Holy Ground is committed to protecting, nurturing, and improving the lives of both mother and child. Our Mission is to shelter and mentor homeless, pregnant and parenting teen girls and their children in Palm Beach County.

What We Do

- ◆ **Shelter** - utilizing an independent living model we provide our clients with financial assistance for rent and utilities for an individual apartment which we, in cooperation with a partner organization, completely furnish.
- ◆ **Mentoring** - each client is provided with a team of adult female mentors who accompany and guide them on their journey from adolescence to adulthood and motherhood. Mentors are also vital in assessing the progress and needs of both mother and child.
- ◆ **Social Services** - clients are assisted in accessing essential resources: healthcare, education, childcare, vocational training, parenting and independent living skills, etc. as warranted.
- ◆ **Essential Resources** – clients are assisted in the purchase of essential resources such as diapers, baby wipes, food, medication, etc. as needed. We also provide transportation for our clients and their children when warranted.

Our Commitment

Holy Ground volunteers and staff are dedicated to making a long-term commitment to each client so that they and their children have the essentials to become healthy, happy, and productive citizens of the community. In exchange, clients are expected to adhere to a behavioral contract that covers a wide range of expectations and behaviors, work part-time and provide a portion of their net income toward their rent and utilities. We also expect our clients to continue their education or obtain vocational training leading to financial independence. Our ultimate goal is to break the cycle of teen pregnancy and move toward ending teen homelessness and poverty in Palm Beach County.
